Entry Requirements:

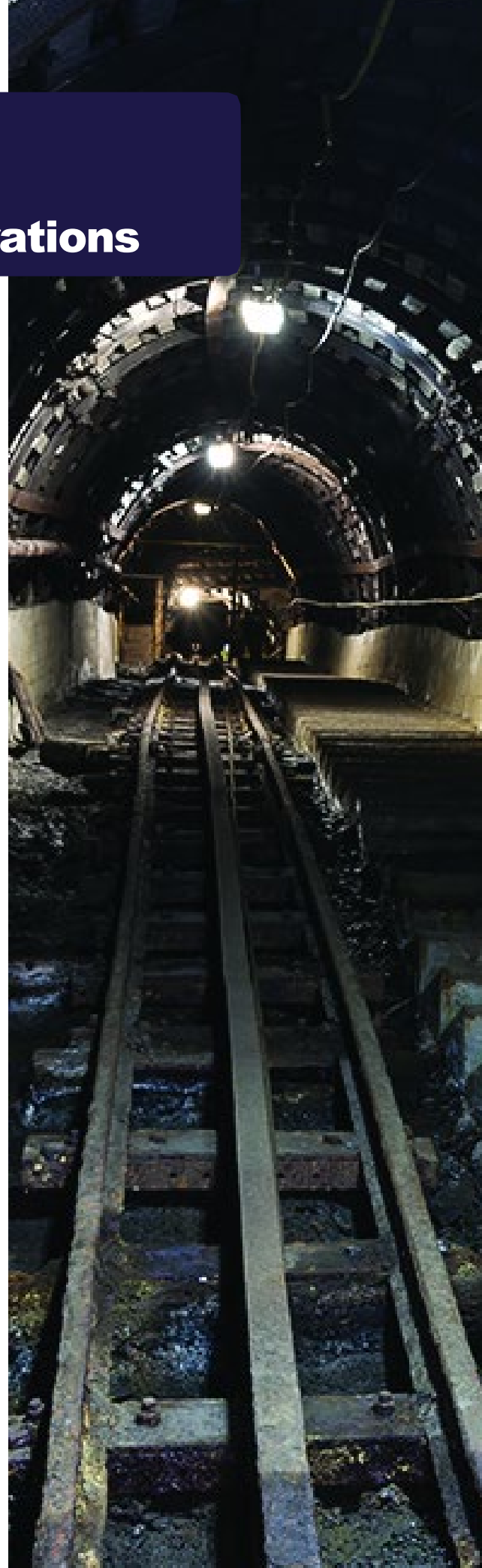
Learners must be 16 years or older and provide photo Identification is required to be sighted prior to course commencement.
