Working Safely at Heights

Introduction:

Designed For:

The Working Safely at Heights course is designed for students required to undertake working at heights tasks in a variety of situations, on and around various structures and in differing work environments including working near unprotected edges or slopes. The course is designed to give instruction on completing working at heights risk assessments, practical application skills and pre and post inspection techniques.

Description:

This course gives both theory and practical instruction on working safely at heights in the workplace. It includes risk assessment, pre and post use inspection of equipment, job step planning (JSA/SWMS) and practical application of working at heights including installing equipment as per Australian Standards, WorkSafe, OH&S and other statutory requirements.

Duration:

9 hours - max. 8 students.

Entry Requirements:

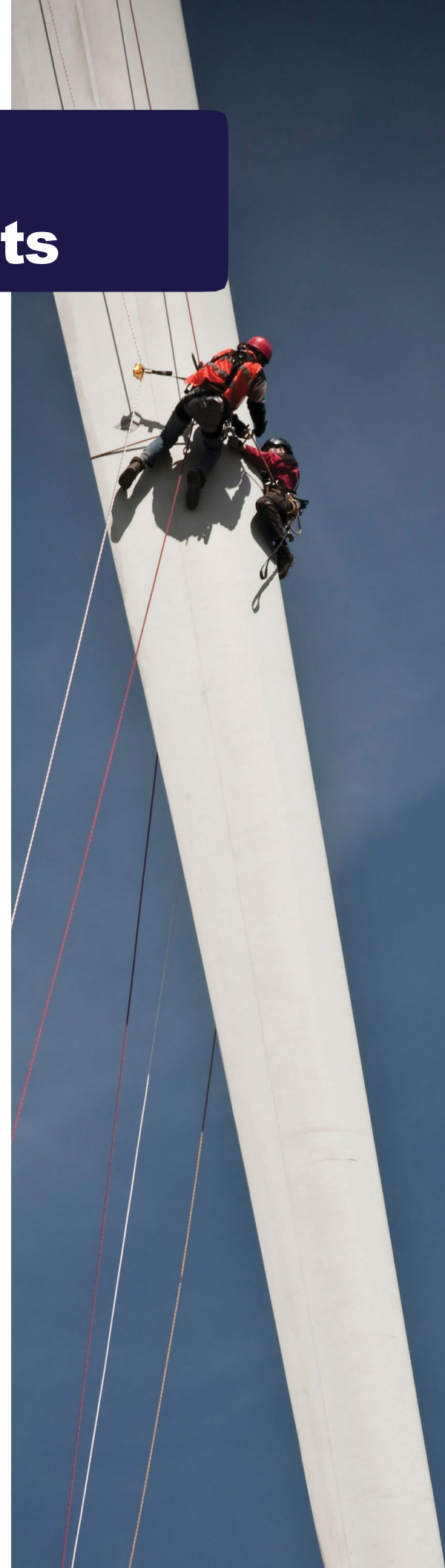
Learners must be 16 years or older and provide photo Identification is required to be sighted prior to course commencement.

Assessment:

Students will be assessed on practical activities and a written assessment.

Delivery Method:

This course is delivered at customer sites via PowerPoint presentations, audio-visual material, individual and group activities and practical applications which simulate real working environments. Students are required to bring PPE including high visibility clothing (long sleeve shirt and pants), steel cap shoes, safety glasses and rigging gloves.
