About the Program

- A percentage of the proceeds from each Bullivants Grade 100 Chain Sling Assemblies sold will be donated directly by Bullivants towards the program.
- All packaging on the Bullivants Chain Sling assemblies will display point of sale material to promote the scholarship program.
- The scholarship program is open to University students studying 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th or 5th year Engineering or equivalent degrees. Two students will be granted financial support to cover living expenses and resource costs to the value of \$10,000 per student/per annum.
- Bullivants have connected with Aurora Education Foundation to support and encourage Indigenous Australians to achieve their tertiary education and career aspirations.

Bullivants will also offer these students the opportunity to gain valuable hands on experience and knowledge at a Bullivants branch during breaks.
